Notice for manual Centralized Mop-up Counseling for State Medical Quota and Private College Management Medical Quota 2019

A centralized Manual Mop Up Round is conducted in pursuance of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP Civil 267 of 2017 dt. 9.05.2017. The venue of manual counseling will be at Medical College, Kolkata, 88 College Street, Kolkata-700073. The U N B Hall, opposite to the Principal office in the administrative block is selected for manual counseling room. The eligible candidates for manual Mop Up (the list will be published in www.wbmcc.nic.in website) have to report at the ground floor of the academic building, situated by the side of the U N B Hall with their original credentials and have to **collect the token** and have to wait in the academic building for their turn of manual round.

The original documents that are required for the manual Mop Up Round are listed as under:

1. **Valid ID card** of all the eligible candidates (ADHAR, Voter, PAN, Passport, Driving license, School / College ID, Bank passbook with photo)
2. The eligible candidates who are at present admitted in a medical / dental college of West Bengal, have to bring their **admission slip**, generated online that shows **their willingness for Mop Up round** as **"YES"** (Admission slip generated in round 2 for up graded and freshly allotted candidates in Round 2 and **admission slip generated in Round 1** for candidates not up graded in Round 2).
3. The eligible candidates who are not allotted any seat in Round1 or Round 2 or freshly registered for Mop Up Round have to bring **printout of online willingness for Mop Up Round** obtained through in www.wbmcc.nic.in website.
4. The **successfully verified slip** for the eligible candidates enrolled in the State Quota and not allotted yet.
5. **The acknowledgement slip downloaded after successful enrollment and payment** in pre counseling for the eligible candidates enrolled in the private management quota only not allotted yet.

Candidates without the above credentials (as applicable) are not permitted to attend the manual centralized Mop Up Counseling.

Eligible candidate list for manual Centralized Mop Up Round along with vacant seats will be published after 4 p.m. on 6.08.2019 in the counseling website www.wbmcc.nic.in

The reporting time for the above eligible candidates is from 9 a.m. on 7.08.2019. The reporting desk will close at 10 a.m. on same day. The candidate last found stand in queue at 10 a.m. will be considered as the last eligible candidate for the manual Centralized Mop Up Counseling. No further request for reporting will be entertained once the reporting desk is closed. If the candidate does not report in time, then, he/she can't participate manual Centralized Mop Up Counseling. Non eligible, non registered candidates or eligible candidates without appropriate original credentials are not allowed to participate manual Centralized Mop Up Counseling and they are not allowed in and around counseling premises. Among the registered candidates, who are not reported or surrendered seats – they are not allowed in manual Centralized Mop Up Counseling.

The possible vacancies may be in the category of ST,SC, OBC-A,OBC-B, EWS and Unreserved in the State Quota and Private Management Quota and NRI Quota (separate date and time for NRI Quota counseling will be there which will be notified separately). The eligible candidates in the list of Private Management Quota seats only, are not allowed to provide choice for State Quota seats. The eligible candidates for State Quota seats are on the other hand allowed to provide choice for State Quota/ Private Management Quota seats. Both the above sets of candidates are not allowed to participate in NRI Quota counseling.

The eligible candidates will be displayed the vacant seats at the counseling venue via LCD Projectors. One projection will be inside the U N B Hall, where only the eligible candidates will be allowed to enter as per instructions of the officials of the Medical College, Kolkata for providing choice in the manual Centralized Mop Up Counseling. Parents are not allowed to enter along with them. There will be provision of public address system.

Calling and allotment of Candidates for manual Centralized Mop Up Counseling (giving choice for the College vacant at the time of calling as per merit according to the All India Rank, caste and domicile status):-

It is pertinent to mention that category candidates of State Quota while they are called for vacant category seats any, they will be asked whether they want the category seats or want to wait for the call from the combined list, later on. If they select the category seat, then they will not be called from the combined list again for obvious reasons. If they do not accept any category seat only then they are gain given a chance of selection through combined list later on, provided they have scored 50th percentile or higher marks in NEET UG 2019. Category candidates of other states (non domicile to West Bengal) are to be treated as NRI only.

Other salient points:-

1. Candidates who are at present allotted and admitted in a seat, if select a seat in manual round, then their earlier seat is forfeited and added to the vacant seat table and they are now allotted to their newly chosen seats. They have to report the newly chosen seats compulsorily; else, their candidature will be cancelled.

2. If a candidate is already admitted in a college finds his/her name in the eligible list for manual round, does not turn up at the manual counseling, then he/she will retain his/her earlier admitted seat.
3. If a candidate admitted presently in a seat does not find any suitable seat of his/her choice during manual round and regrets then also, he/she will retain the earlier admitted seats.

Up graded candidates in manual round have to first go to previous college or private college admission desk at WBUHS to take online release and then have to report to newly allotted college/private college admission desk at WBUHS for online reporting with all necessary documents, fee and bonds as already stated and published in counseling website www.wbmcc.nic.in. No admission is possible after 4 p.m. of 12.08.2019 as per server time. The vacant seats after 4 p.m. of 12.08.2019 will be transferred to the respected colleges with non allotted candidate list for filling up any stray vacancy by the college themselves in pursuance to the Hon'ble Apex Court Order.
