### **Notice for admission in Round 1 for candidates allotted through West Bengal State Quota and Private Management Quota counseling for UG Medical and Dental seats 2019**

Allotted candidates in round 1 are directed to report to the respective allotted institutes from 10.07.2019 to 12.07.2019 during the working hours 10 am till 4 pm for admission. For private colleges the admission counter will be functional at the premises of West Bengal University Of Health Sciences Building during the working hours 10 am till 4 pm for the days of admission as per schedule published in the website [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) where both the Private Medical/Dental college authorities and the allotted candidates are requested to attend for completion of the admission and fee payment formalities.

The college authorities are directed to admit candidates after checking the original documents and self attested photocopies of the candidates allotted to them through online counseling. The result -will be published in [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) website as per schedule.

The documents that are required during admission in original and one self-attested photocopy are stated herewith:-

- i. Admit Card of NEET UG 2019.
- ii. Score card/ Result/ Rank letter NEET UG 2019.
- iii. Date of Birth Certificate/ Class 10 Certificate/Class 10 admit card as Age Proof { age of candidate must be 17 years by 31.12.2019}
- iv. Class 10+2 Certificate (May be relaxed if candidate passed in 2018 or 2019).
- v. Class 10+2 Marks Sheet ( All candidates must pass Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English separately and combined aggregate of marks in Physics+Chemistry+ Biology must be 50% or more for UR candidate/45% or more for PH candidate /40% or more for SC,ST, OBC A or OBC B candidate in 10+2 examination).
- vi. Provisional allotment letter generated on-line from website [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in)
- vii. Any one Valid Proof of identity (School or college ID card/Voter card/Aadhar card/Passport/Driving license/PAN card).
- viii. Medical Certificate from Registered Allopathic Medical Practitioner
- ix. FINAL SUCCESSFULLY VERIFIED SLIP generated online from [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) for State Quota document verified candidates at the verification centers or ACKNOWLEDGEMENT SLIP showing online payment proof during the pre

counseling phase in West Bengal for candidates eligible for Private Management quota seats only.

- x. (xi) The Candidate should also bring the following certificate, if applicable:
- (a) SC/ST/OBC A/OBC B Certificate issued by the competent authority. The OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer to claim OBC reservation benefit.
  - (b) Benchmark Physical Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of IPGMER Kolkata issued within stipulated time frame. No other PH certificate, issued by any other Authorities/Hospital will be entertained. The benchmark disabilities are as per disability act of 2016.

**During admission, college authorities will keep all the self attested photocopies and all the original documents except Age proof, ID card and caste certificate and will issue a receipt stating that such and such original documents are kept along with the college authorities.**

If 10+2 certificate is not available for the candidate who has passed in the year 2018 or 2019, a declaration have to be taken from the candidates to submit the said document before the college authorities at the earliest best.

The deposited documents will only be handed over to the candidate during the upgradation from that college to another college in Round 2 or later rounds of State Quota and Private Management Quota counseling in West Bengal OR If candidate resigns before publication of vacant seats for centralized mop up counseling due to any cause OR If candidate deposits the bond sum as penalty { applicable after publication of vacant seats for centralized mop up round of counseling as the resigned seat cannot be added for allotment thence} OR After the completion of the course including one year compulsory rotatory internship as the case may be.

**The bond amount is Rs one lakh only for State Govt. of West Bengal institutions.** For Private colleges and ESI Joka Medical College, candidates are requested to contact the respective colleges regarding bond criteria.

The candidate has to submit the bond in each round of admission/up gradation to the respective college in non judicial stamp paper of Rs 10/- minimum along with demy paper if required for. During up gradation from one college to another the earlier submitted bond statement will become invalid and a new bond has to be submitted in newly admitted college.

The penalty will only be applicable if candidate wants to resign from the admitted seat due to any reason, after publication of the vacant seat matrix for centralized mop up counseling in the website [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in).

The amount of fee deposited during the admission is divided into the admission fee (**non refundable**), tuition fee for the first 6 months (first semester) and caution deposit. The tuition fee and caution deposit are refundable if the candidate is upgraded in Round 2 or later round or resigns from the admitted seat before publication of vacant seat matrix of manual round. In no case the tuition fees or caution deposit are refundable after the publication of the vacant seat matrix of centralized mop up counseling. Moreover, such candidate has to pay the bond penalty to the concerned college.

Candidates must consult the Private colleges for fee to be deposited during admission for State Quota and Management Quota seats. The contact details of the private colleges are provided in the **Participating institute information** in [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) website for ready reference to the candidates.

The candidate if upgraded from one State Govt. of West Bengal institute to another in subsequent round/s in the same course, then he/she need not submit fee afresh, instead they are allowed to deposit the fee receipt of previous college to the newly upgraded college. This facility is for West Bengal State Govt. College to another West Bengal State Govt. college if the fees and course are same.

For upgradation from Private college to Govt. college or vice versa or from Dental college to Medical college or from Private college to another private college or to the College of ESI Joka or COMJNMH Kalyani, the admission fee will be forfeited and tuition fee with caution deposit will be refunded to the candidate. The candidate has to pay fee afresh in the newly allotted institute.

The candidates are requested to contact respective institutes for amount of admission fee, tuition fee and caution deposit or any other fee applicable during admission process. The contact details of the private colleges are provided in the **Participating institute information** in [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) website for ready reference to the candidates.

The admission has to be done through a web based portal provided to the allotted colleges. All the allotted candidates must ensure that they get web based admission at the allotted college/college counter at WBUHS (as the case may be), there by obtaining the web generated Admission letter.

If any candidate fails to get admitted by depositing the requisite original documents and fees during the stipulated date and time, then the admission will be cancelled and the candidate will be out of the counseling process.

The candidate has to provide willingness for subsequent round during the web based admission at the allotted college. If they are willing for participation in subsequent round/s, then he/she will be able to participate in subsequent round/s (as the case may be). No change in willingness will be entertained thereafter.
