NOTICE

Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in consultation with National Board of Examinations reduced the cut off percentile in the NEET PG MDS earlier.

Similarly, relaxation of 7.5 marks has been reduced by the Ministry with Medical Council of India effecting eligibility to 42.5 percentile for unreserved category candidates and 32.5 percentile for reserved category candidates. Therefore, notice for counseling for NEET PG 2017 will be followed soon. There is likelihood that a section of candidates will get revised rank while such revised rank happens to illustrate in following example.

Suppose, a reserved category candidate gets 48.5 percentile and his rank is 12345 (hypothetical) and after relaxation of marks an unreserved candidate obtained 49 percentile is now eligible but his combined rank must be higher than the candidate mentioned just now. Therefore, the rank of 12345 will change and similarly all the ranks down the line will change. For all practical purposes, candidates who get revised rank other than the candidates, are now eligible for relaxation of marks will be identified with both the ranks to avoid any complications.

The candidates whose marks are relaxed will continue to visit the website <u>www.wbmes.nic.in</u> and there should not be any doubt for revised rank mentioned by the National Board of Examinations.
