Important Notification of West Bengal Post Graduate Medical and Dental Online Counselling for State Quota seats and Private Management Quota seats 2018

State Quota seats:-

All eligible candidates as figured in the final lists after verifications for State Quota seats are allowed to exercise choice for all seats in State Quota irrespective of caste (UR, SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, OBC); Status (PH or Not PH) and Category (Open or In-service). Scope of filling up choices is for one time only during the process of counselling.

Further it is mentioned that the seat matrix containing the actual vacancy (as stood on 28.03.2018) in Round 1 according to caste, status and category will be published on 29.03.2018.

Candidates are allowed to fill choice in the seats including virtual seats that do not exist in the seat matrix of Round 1.

These choices will be considered in further round/s expecting:-

- Addition of new seats
- Return of vacant All India Quota seats
- Conversion of seats between caste, status and category.
- Addition of seats due to non joining/surrender/non allotment in earlier round or any other cause

Candidates are directed to be alert and cautious in exercising of choice keeping in mind the following points in particular:-

- Candidates must exercise choices in order of his/her priority. Scope of filling up choices is for one time only throughout the process of counseling. Candidates are to preferably give choices for the category in which s/he belongs as priority.
- Candidates should not fill such choice where he/she is not interested to take admission if allotted else the candidate will be out of the counseling process and liable for penal action.
- Candidates are directed to fill such choice where he/she is interested to take admission even though that seat is not included in the actual seat matrix of Round 1 expecting new addition, return of AIQ seats, conversion of seats and addition of seats due to other cause in subsequent round/s.
- Candidates are directed to take note of the above criteria in filling of choices as exercising of fresh option will not be allowed in the subsequent round/s.
- In Round 1, allotment will be done according to the actual seat matrix of Round 1.
- Those who are allotted seats in Round 1 must take admission in the allotted institute else they will be out of counseling process.
- During admission in Round 1, the candidates have to exercise willingness to participate in subsequent round/s for choice up gradation. Else their choices will not be considered for up gradation in the subsequent round/s and they will retain the seat of Round 1. If any candidate is not willing to upgrade his choices, s/he will opt for "no" in the willingness for up gradation. In that case his/her admitted seat will be retained.
- The candidates who take admission after getting allotment in Round 1 and exercise willingness to participate in subsequent round/s, their higher choices **exercised in round 1** (both for real and virtual seats) as per his/her priority will be considered for up gradation in subsequent round/s.

- i. The candidates who were not allotted any seat in Round 1, their all choices (both for real and virtual seats) will be considered for fresh allotment in subsequent round/s.
- j. The candidates willing to fill choice in the State Quota seats of Private Medical/Dental Colleges including Management Quota seats must be sure about the fee structure of the institution because they have to take admission in that institution **after depositing requisite fee** if allotted else they will be out of the counseling process.

Example is cited for clarification:-

- a. An Unreserved (UR) candidate may exercise choice in Round 1 in seats of SC/ST/OBC and PH besides the UR seat according to his/her priority
- b. Similarly a reserved candidate may opt for choice in Round 1 in all caste reserve seats and also in unreserved seats and PH seats according to his /her priority.
- c. Open category candidates may give choice for in-service category seats and vice versa.
- d. **All seats shown in the seat matrix in Round 1 are open for both** open and in service category candidates irrespective of caste, category, PH status and candidate will give as many as choices after thorough application of mind. Candidates are alerted not to choose seat/ seats for which s/he repents later. As the seat is allotted based on his/her choice, s/he must admit in the allotted seat otherwise it attracts huge penalty and also affects the future prospect of the candidate.

Management Quota seats:-

All candidates eligible for State Quota seats may exercise choice for Private Management Quota seats in Round 1.

The candidates willing to fill choice in the Management Quota seats of Private Medical/Dental Colleges must be sure about the fee structure of the institution because they have to take admission in that institution after **depositing requisite fee** if allotted else they will be out of the counseling process and liable for penal action.

All candidates eligible for State Quota seats have to list the choices of State Quota and Management Quota seats (if wishes to opt for) in order of priority in a single choice list. Candidates eligible for Private Management Quota seats only, have to fill choices of Management Quota in order of priority.

If any candidate is not willing to admit in "Private Management Quota" seat, he/she should not opt for such seat, otherwise, if s/he does not admit after allotment, his candidature will be forfeited and other penal measure will be initiated.

For both the Open and Management Quota seats:-

- a. Non allotted candidates after second round of counseling will only be allowed for participation in Mop Up round (if at all occurs) by deposition of the original documents to the WBUHS. Such candidates if after allotment does not get admitted, will be considered as "admitted and discontinued" the course and attract provision of penalty as per Govt order HF/O/MERT/1542/Admn/ME/STM-28-10 dated Kolkata 25 October 2010.
- b. The candidates who have been allotted seats in AIQ and State Quota in Second and subsequent round of counseling will not be allowed to resign as per order of the Hon"ble Supreme Court of India dated 09.05.2017 in WP Civil 267 of 2017.
- c. Thus candidates are alerted not to opt for such choice for the seats which he/she does not consider for admission after allotment else s/he will attract penalty as stated above.

For NRI quota seats in Private Colleges (if any) a separate notice will be issued soon.
